F) Academic/Infrastructure Details

Initiatives taken for the implementation of National Education Policy (NEP) -2020: College is a place where overall development of student takes place, from this point of view our college plans its annual academic calendar. At the beginning of academic year, Principals meet with student is organized, where principle addresses the student and gives detailed idea about various activities which are organized in college every year.

Bridge course- In order to identify advance and slow learners, each department of college organize a bridge course. The syllabus of bridge course contains Basic concept of the particular subject. The course is of 2 weeks having separate timetable. After completion of bridge course test is conducted and from that is test slow and advance learner are identified.

Activities for slow learners-

1] Slow learners are having less confidence about their subject knowledge, so they need motivation. A special cell like Mentor-Mentee is developed. From that cell counselling of the student about personal issues & curriculum problem are discussed.

2]Audio- visual lectures are organized for slow learners related to their topics.

3] Group discussions are also organized, from that students can communicate their idea of subject to other students, so by that they can gain the confidence about their subject.

4] At the end of each semester previous years question papers were solved. Which helps the slow learners to gain the confidence about the subject.

Activities for advanced learners-

1] Extra reference books are provided to these students so that they can get detailed idea about their subject.

2]They are also motivated to participate in various academic competitions.

3]Lectures from SWAYM/NPTL portal on different topics are made available for the students.

4] various quizzes are also organized for these students.

Activities for Slow and advanced learners-

students are motivated to take part in NSS/ NCC by participating in such cell they can develop their communication skills, at the same time, they can get idea about how to organize any program.

Competitive exam -In order to make awareness about competitive exam, a special cell is prepared. This cell organized lecture of various eminent resource persons who are working in public sector. from these lecture students get motivated

Placement Cell-Our college has special placement cell who has organized two district level campus drive programs.

Placement cell also sign MOU with SEEKA industries Jalgaon.

Sports-Physical fitness is very important, so students are motivated to participate in various sports various events organized by sports department. This department also organized coaching camp for various Sports.

Stress Management Workshop- A workshop is organized about how to manage stress in daily life.

2) College has established various committees for effective implementation of NEP 2020.The committee like Mentor-mentee cell is continuously observing and counselling the students about NEP 2020. Another committee like Vivekanand Circle organizes various programs for effective implementation of Indian knowledge systems. Various activities are organized for advanced & slow learners to achieve the program and learning outcomes.

3) College had made special cell for identification and improvement of soft skills among the students. various activities are taken under this cell regarding the soft skills which is integrated part of NEP 2020.

4) College has made separate cell on competitive exams for the students who wants to do career in administrative posts and established placement cell for job opportunities.
